Dear Non-Profit or Political Organization,

It's that time again, for the 63rd Annual Tennessee Strawberry Festival. The theme for this year is "Strawberry Masquerade". We want everyone to come out and enjoy our festival.

The central location for the Festival is the downtown area of Dayton. The non-food vendors will be located on the Rhea County Courthouse lawn, as in years past. Absolutely no motorized vehicles will be allowed to remain in the vending area or the parking spaces around the courthouse. The Courthouse lawn will be open for business on Friday. The actual dates for the festival are May 1st through May 15th, ***but the vendors will be open for business May 14th and May 15th 2010. You are to be here both days.***

Booth space is \$100 for a 12' x 12' space with electricity provided (please indicate on the application). If additional space is needed, you will be required to purchase it. We will be following strict guidelines and the Tennessee Department of Revenue will be on site for tax purposes. Deadline for entries is March 31, 2010. This is an outdoor event so please prepare accordingly. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS.**

The Festival Committee will assign spaces based on the following criteria:

- Booth space will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Participation during previous festivals does not guarantee booth space. Spaces are limited.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- ***No selling of any kind in a non-profit or political booth.***

Upon acceptance, you will receive a confirmation letter. If you are not accepted, you will be notified and a refund will be issued. ***Confirmation packets will be sent in April 2010.*** The confirmation package will include a parking pass with your booth number and a map of the vending area, instructions on setup time, lodging information, and directions to Dayton.
